INFORMATION ITEMS FOR 11th NOVEMBER 2019

Wigmore Village Hall: There will be an Open Day on Saturday 16th November. It is to highlight the activities in the VH, show the recent updates to the facilities, highlight the community café and (very importantly) advertise for a new VH manager due to Jenny Johnson's imminent departure. Views will also be sort regarding any new services residents would like to see at the VH.

Mortimer Voices: the deadline for the next issue of Mortimer Voices is 15th November.

Highway Matters: There is a proposal to apply for a Highways Stopping Up order which would erect bollards on Bury Lane and so stop HGV's using the lane. The parish council would like to hear residents' views on this proposal.

'Slow Down' and '30mph' Wheely bin stickers: A limited supply of these are available from the clerk. There are instructions as to where and how to use them (on wheely bins only please).

'No Cold Callers' signs: An even more limited supply of these notices are available from the clerk to be given to vulnerable residents to put in windows or front doors.

Vacancy on Parish Council: There is still a vacancy on the parish council for a second parish councillor for Leinthall Starkes. If you would like to get involved in your community then please contact the clerk/chairman for further information.

The Castle Inn: The pub re-opened on 1st November.

Wigmore churchyard: Councillor Dowdy and the Parish Clerk met representatives of the Hereford diocese Diocesan Advisory Committee in Wigmore churchyard. They gave advice with regard to the possible work needed in the churchyard and will produce a report which will also hopefully identify exactly where the boundaries to the churchyard are. They also met with a local builder to get initial costings of the work proposed and are awaiting a quote. Councillors Dowdy and Fraser are due to meet a representative of Caring for God's Acre (a churchyard improvement charity) on 18th November to discuss their possible involvement. *Once all the necessary information is gathered this item will return to the agenda for a decision to be made regarding any further action.*

Water leak on Castle Street, Wigmore: The repairs were done during the week of 22nd October thanks to the persistence of a very determined resident.

Improvements to ground maintenance in Kings/Queens Meadow: Councillor Thomas has matters in hand regarding this. *Once all the necessary information is gathered this item will return to the agenda for a decision to be made regarding any further action*

Planning Updates:

192598 - – Aston Motte House, Pipe Aston, SY8 2HG – Proposed construction of general purpose storage barn and workshop. The barn will be used for domestic and agricultural storage including some building material and joinery items for estate property maintenance and repair, the workshop will be used for agricultural maintenance and occasional use in association with estate properties. *(Approved with conditions)*

190602 – Wigmore Hall, Cider House, Wigmore, HR6 9UL – Proposed conversion of a redundant building to a dwelling together with the installation of a garage and access drive. This application is a variation of the previous LBC ref 160283L. Retrospective. *(Waiting a decision)*

191427 – Bank Cottage, Wigmore HR6 9UF – Alteration and improvements to existing vehicular and pedestrian access. *(Waiting a decision)*

191771 – Land at the Old Blacksmiths Yard, Leinthall Starkes – Conversion of a redundant rural building into a single residential dwelling. *(Waiting a decision)*

192220 & 192221 – Elton Farm, Elton SY8 2HQ, C1019 From Westfield Farm to St Mary's Church Elton – Proposed barn conversion.; *(Waiting a decision)*
